Dear Tribal Members,

Lt. Governor Gib Miles and I along with the Legislators have decided to extend the return-to-work date for tribal and casino employees to Monday, April 20, 2020. It has become necessary for the Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes to continue providing essential services only due to the ongoing and uncontained COVID-19 pandemic. Extended paid leave will be provided to Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribal and Lucky Star Employees during this time.

The Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes are committed to doing our part in containing this virus and realize the need to continue social distancing in an effort to keep tribal members, employees, and patrons healthy and safe.

In addition, it is with great regret and necessary that all tribal Easter activities to be cancelled.

This decision is subject to change for both the Tribes and the casino as well as for the employees, as we continue to monitor the effects of this virus on our nation and communities. If changes are necessary, employees will be provided information as soon as possible. An amended Executive Order regarding the COVID-19 pandemic will be forthcoming.
