**SUBJECT:** A Resolution requesting appropriation for the **FY 2022 HHS-2021-ACF-ANA-NA-1906** Administration of Native American (ANA) Social Economic Development Strategies (SEDS) grant application.

**WHEREAS:** The Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes are federally recognized Indian Tribes, organized under a Constitution approved by the Secretary of the Interior on April 4, 2006; and

**WHEREAS:** The Legislature has the Constitutional obligation and public responsibility to the Tribes to oversee the Tribes' operations in order to establish and promote justice, establish guidance and direction for the government and advance the general welfare of the Tribes; and

**WHEREAS:** Article VII, Section 4(d) of the Constitution requires that the Legislature or Tribal Council give prior authorization for the signing of contracts by the Governor; and

**WHEREAS:** Article VI, Section 7(a) of the Constitution, the Legislative Process provides that all Bills shall be published in a Legislative Calendar for at least thirty days prior to action on Bill; and

**WHEREAS:** The Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes Department of Administration, Respect program is requesting appropriations to match 20% of the **FY 2022 HHS-2021-ACF-ANA-NA-1906** Administration of Native American (ANA) Social Economic Development Strategies (SEDS) grant application 36-month project period with three 12-month budget periods, Award Ceiling of \$ 400,000.00 per budget period totaling \$ 1,200,000.00 federal funding; and

**WHEREAS:** The Department of Administration, Respect Program 20% match of the **FY 2022 HHS-2021-ACF-ANA-NA-1906** Administration of Native American (ANA) Social Economic Development Strategies (SEDS) grant application 36-month project period with three 12-month budget periods at \$ 80,000.00 per budget period totaling \$ 240,000.00 tribal funding; and


**WHEREAS:** The **FY 2022 HHS-2021-ACF-ANA-NA-1906** Administration of Native American (ANA) Social Economic Development Strategies (SEDS) grant application 36-month project period with three 12-month budget periods with the grant application Due Date of April 15, 2022 with anticipated project start date of September 30, 2022; and

**WHEREAS:** The Respect Program will designate several sites throughout the Cheyenne and Arapaho service area in which grant funding will be used in the Development of Outdoor recreational facilities for youth, family and community health and well-being; and

**WHEREAS:** The Ninth Legislature finds it necessary and proper to support and commit to the grant and appropriates \$ 80,000.00 per budget period of the **FY 2022 HHS-2021-ACF-ANA-NA-1906** Administration of Native American (ANA) Social Economic Development Strategies (SEDS) grant application 36-month project period with three 12-month budget periods, total of \$ 240,000.00 tribal funding; and

**WHEREAS:** The Department of Administration, Respect Program hereby accepts the terms and conditions if awarded: and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Ninth Legislature of the Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes authorizes Governor Reggie Wassana to sign all contracts and related documents for **FY 2022 HHS-2021-ACF-ANA-NA-1906** Administration for Native Americans (ANA) Social Economic Development Strategies (SEDS) grant application.
