LEGISLATIVE HISTORY:

[NOTE: Except as otherwise noted, the provisions of this Resolution, was enacted into Law by the Seventh Legislature of the Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes in the 25th Special Session, by a roll call vote on November 5, 2019 by Resolution No. 7L-SS-2019-1105-003 A Resolution to Reactivate the Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes Tribal Designated Housing Entity (TDHE) Under the Umbrella of the Department of Housing.]

SUBJECT: A Resolution to Confirm Wanda Whiteman to the position of Housing Authority, Board of Commissioners.

WHEREAS: The Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes are duly recognized by the United States Secretary of the Interior as a self-governing, Sovereign Nation, that is a federally recognized Indian Tribe with all rights, privileges, and powers attended thereto as a sovereign government, and organized in accordance with Title 25 of the United States Code, Section 450, the “Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act,” and Article XVII of the Tribe’s Constitution and By-Laws and Section 3 of the Oklahoma Indian Welfare Act of June 26, 1936 (49 Stat. 1967), under an amended Constitution ratified on August, 2006 and approved by the Secretary of Interior on May 17, 2006; and

WHEREAS: Article VI, Section 5, subsection (a) of the Constitution grants the Legislature the power to make laws and resolutions in accordance with the Constitution which are necessary and proper for the good of the Tribes; and

WHEREAS: Article VI, Section 5, subsection (a) of the Constitution requires that all actions by the Legislature shall be embodied in a written Law or Resolution; and

WHEREAS: The Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes has determined that the Housing Authority is an active entity and the Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes opts to reactivate the Housing Authority under the Department of Housing Resolution 7L-SS-2019-1105-003; and


WHEREAS: The Housing Authority of the Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes is a duly created Tribal Designated Housing Entity (TDHE) pursuant to the authority found in the statues of the state of Oklahoma, including particularly, the Oklahoma Housing Authorities Act of 1965; and

WHEREAS: Oklahoma Housing Authorities Act 1965 §63-1058. Appointments, Qualifications, tenure, and meeting of Authority commissioners shall consist of five (5) board members appointed to staggered three (3) year terms; and

WHEREAS: Art. VI Sec. 5(g)(h) of the Constitution provides that [a]ny [m]embers of all Commissions shall be selected by nomination by the Governor, subject to confirmation by the Legislature and [m]embers of all Boards shall be selected by election as required by law, or by nomination by the Governor, subject to confirmation by the Legislature; and

WHEREAS: Governor Reggie Wassana now nominates Wanda Whiteman to serve in the position of Housing Authority, Board of Commissioners for a three-year term, with said term starting 5/01/2022 and with an expiration date of 4/30/2025 and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Ninth Legislature of the Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes, pursuant to its Constitutional power, hereby confirms Wanda Whiteman to the position of Housing Authority, Board of Commissioners, in accordance with Art. VI Sec. 5(g)(h) of the Constitution.



If the Tribal Council fails to repeal such law or resolution at the next Tribal Council where the matter has been properly placed on the agenda for the Tribal Council meeting, such law or resolution shall become effective immediately."
