WHEREAS: The Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes ("Tribes") are federally recognized Indian tribes, organized under a Constitution approved by Tribal membership on

April 4, 2006, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior; and

WHEREAS: Article VI, Section 5(a) and (c) in the Constitution provides that "Legislative power shall be vested in the Legislature" and "[t]he Legislature shall have the power to make laws and resolutions in accordance with the Constitution which are

necessary and proper for the good of the Tribes;" and

WHEREAS: Article VII, Section 4(d) provides the Governor with "the power to negotiate and sign a contract, other than a gaming management contract, which has been previously authorized by the Tribal Council or Legislature;" and

WHEREAS: The Clinton Child Development Center is approximately 20 years old, the kitchen at this site is out dated, non-commercial, and provides meal services three times per day in inadequate preparation facilities for both Child Care and Head Start: and

WHEREAS: PG&C completed the procurement process for the building remodel, the kitchen component was sole sourced to complete the project. The amount for the kitchen remodel is \$442,850.00. The funding has been allocated for the remodel and will be funded solely with Federal Funds; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Ninth Legislature of the Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes, does hereby approve of the contract with CRW Home Improvement Company for the Clinton Child Care and Head Start Kitchen Renovations; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Ninth Legislature of the Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes, pursuant to Article VII, Section 4(d) of the Tribal Constitution authorizes Governor Reggie Wassana to sign the CRW contract and any other related documents needed for the Clinton Child Care and Head Start Renovations.
