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**SUBJECT:** A Resolution to Appropriate Funds to the Cheyenne and Arapaho Business Development Corporation.

**WHEREAS:** The Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes are federally recognized Indian Tribes, organized under a Constitution approved by the Secretary of the Interior on April 4, 2006, and

**WHEREAS:** The Legislature has the Constitutional obligation and public responsibility to the Tribes to oversee the Tribes' operations in order to establish and promote justice, establish guidance and direction for the government and advance the general welfare of the Tribes; and

**WHEREAS:** Article VI, Section 5(a) of the Constitution provides that Legislative power shall reside with the Legislature; and

**WHEREAS:** Article VI, Section 5(d) of the Constitution states that the Legislature shall have the power to raise revenue and appropriate funds for expenditure; and


**WHEREAS:** The Tribes statutorily created the Cheyenne and Arapaho Business Development Corporation ("Corporation"), a wholly owned corporation of the tribe, at a Special Session on May 23, 2019; and

**WHEREAS:** The Corporation was in its infancy and had only been in operation for less than three months before the Coronavirus pandemic swept across the world in 2020 causing businesses everywhere to slow down dramatically or stop conducting business altogether; and

**WHEREAS:** The purpose of this appropriation is to help the Corporation fund new personnel, supplies, and equipment; and

**WHEREAS:** The Corporation would like to seek approval from the Legislature to appropriate an amount up to but not to exceed \$320,000 to fund personnel, supplies, and equipment; and

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Ninth Legislature of the Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes does hereby appropriate Gaming funds in an amount not to exceed \$320,000 that will allow the Corporation to fund personnel, supplies, and equipment.



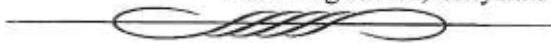

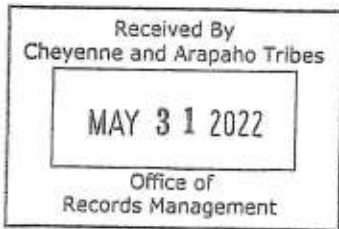
